ESG 410 SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

*** IMPORTANT – CAREFULLY READ ALL THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT BELOW BEFORE USING THE SOFTWARE. ***

This is a valid and legally enforceable agreement made and entered between you (either an individual or a single entity) and Olympus Corporation ("Olympus"). The Software includes Olympus' and/or its licensors' computer program, associated printed materials, data, information and their updated or extended versions thereof and the instruction manual for the Software ("Manual"). BY INSTALLING, COPYING, DOWNLOADING, ACCESSING OR OTHERWISE USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

Section I. (Software)

1. All title and rights to the Software are owned by Olympus or its licensors.
2. The Software is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties.

Section II. (Grant of License)

1. Olympus grants to you a non-exclusive license to use the Software free of charge subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
2. Olympus retains all rights, title and interest in and to the Software including without limitation all copyrights and other proprietary rights.
3. The Software may include (i) some open source software and (ii) other third party software (collectively, "Third Party Software"). Regarding the use of the Third Party Software, you shall follow the license terms and conditions applied to such Third Party Software made available with the Software, its Documentation or at Section IX below. Any part of this Agreement does not restrict, change or alter any of your rights and obligations imposed by the license terms and conditions of the Third Party Software.

Section III. Section III. (Conditions of Use)

4. Except as provided in a separate software license agreement or as explicitly permitted by Olympus in writing, you may only install and use the Software on each HF generator ESG 410 (hereinafter the "Medical Device") in your possession.

5. You may copy the Software only for the purposes of a) downloading the Software from our download server, b) installation of the Software on the Medical Device and/or c) backup and documentation.
6. The Software made available on Olympus download server is subject to change without notice. The End User shall bear the sole responsibility for proper version control, documentation and successful completion of any software updates installed on the Medical Device. Olympus recommends regularly checking the download server for updates.
7. The healthcare provider operating the Medical Device acknowledges that the Software is considered as 'Software in a Medical Device'. It is the obligation and sole responsibility of the healthcare provider to train and instruct all users to follow all mandatory requirements for the maintenance and safe operation of the Medical Device after each update. The healthcare provider shall follow the instructions in the Service Manual of the Medical Device and any security notifications that Olympus may issue from time to time via its Customer Service channels (including email notifications and online alerts).

Section IV. (Rental and Transfer)

You may not rent, lease, sublicense or lend the Software, any of its copy or the Manual. You may, however, transfer all of your rights under this Agreement in conjunction with a transfer of the HF generator ESG 410, provided you retain no copies of the Software, and the recipient agrees to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

Section V. (Restrictions)

1. You may not transfer, sell, lent, distribute or reproduce a whole or part of the Software or the Manual without Olympus' prior approval. You may not sublicense any rights granted under this Agreement to a third party.
2. You may transfer all of your rights under this Agreement in conjunction with a transfer of the HF generator ESG 410, provided you retain no copies of the Software, and the recipient agrees to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
3. You may not create, transfer, sell, distribute, rent or lease any derivative work of the Software or the Manual.
4. You may not analyze, reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the Software, DLL or any part of the Software or print out the Software.
5. You may not combine the Software with or incorporate it into any other application software.

6. You agree that the Software is subject to the export control laws and regulations of Japan, U.S.A. and other competent countries. You shall follow any such applicable export control laws and regulations of Japan, U.S.A. and other countries.
7. You may not alter, erase or deface any trademark, warning, copyright and other notice on the Software.
8. Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement or the Manual, you may not make any copy of the Software for any purpose other than back up.

Section VI. Section VI. (Confidentiality)

You will treat the Software as a trade secret and proprietary information belonging to Olympus that is being made available to Licensee in confidence. Licensee agrees to treat the Software with at least the same care as it treats its own highly confidential or proprietary information, but not less than reasonable care. Olympus will not use any information provided by Licensee that is marked confidential or that a reasonable person would presume is confidential for any purpose other than to provide the Software and Maintenance under this Agreement.

Section VII. Section VII. (Limited Warranties, Exclusions)

1. Olympus warrants to you that for a period of thirty (30) days following delivery of the Software to Licensee that the Software will perform substantially in conformance with the Documentation. Olympus does not warrant that the Software will meet all of Licensee's requirements or that the use of the Software will be uninterrupted or error-free. The foregoing warranty applies only to failures in operation of the Software that are reproducible in standalone form and does not apply to: (i) a failure by Licensee to operate the Software within the systems requirements provided for the Software or Licensee's use of the Software in combination with other products not provided or expressly approved by Olympus; (ii) Software that is modified or altered by Licensee or any third party that is not authorized, in writing, by Olympus; (iii) Software that is operated in violation of this Agreement or other than in accordance with the Documentation; (iv) failures that are caused by other software or hardware products; or (v) Licensee's failure or refusal to implement maintenance releases. To the maximum extent permitted under applicable law, as Olympus and its supplier's entire liability, and as Licensee's exclusive remedy for any breach of the foregoing warranty, Olympus will, at its sole option and expense, promptly repair or replace any Software that fails to meet this limited warranty or, if Olympus is unable to repair or replace the Software, terminate the license and refund to Licensee a pro-rated portion of the applicable license fees for the period following termination, which shall be paid upon return of the



nonconforming item to Olympus. The warranty is void if failure of the Software has resulted from accident, abuse, or misapplication. Any replacement Software will be warranted for thirty (30) days.

2. EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY STATED IN THIS SECTION, THE SOFTWARE IS LICENSED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, NON-INFRINGEMENT, AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

Section VIII. Section VIII. (Limitation of Liability)

1. Injury or Death: We shall indemnify and hold you harmless from and against all claims, losses and liabilities, of whatever kind or nature, including attorneys' fees and costs, asserted against Gyrus Medical Limited for injury or death to persons or damage to property as a result of acts or omissions of the Supplier, the Supplier's agents or employees.
2. NOTWITHSTANDING THE MANDATORY PROVISIONS APPLICABLE FOR THE MEDICAL DEVICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL PRODUCT LIABILITY LAWS, OLYMPUS SHALL NOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES SUFFERED OR INCURRED BY YOU OR ANY OTHER THIRD PARTY (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, GENERAL, SPECIAL, DIRECT, INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES INCLUDING DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF BUSINESS PROFITS, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, LOSS OF BUSINESS INFORMATION AND THE LIKE), ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE DELIVERY, USE OR PERFORMANCE OF THE SOFTWARE ALONE.

Such terms apply even if Olympus and Licensee have a separate signed agreement related to the Software.
2. Pass Through Terms. Included in the Software is certain software called LZ4 – Fast LZ compression algorithm ("LZ4 Software"). You are authorized to use the LZ4 Software as part of the Software subject to the following restrictions:

With regards to the Run-Time Module it is prohibited to: (a) copying the Run-Time Module, except for archive purposes consistent with the End User's archive procedures; (b) transferring the Run-Time Module to a third party apart from the Target Application; (c) modifying, decompiling, disassembling, reverse engineering or otherwise attempting to derive the Source Code of the Run-Time Module; (d) exporting the Run-Time Module or underlying technology in contravention of applicable U.S. and foreign export laws and regulations; and (e) using the Run-Time Module other than in connection with operation of the Software.

The Run-Time Module is licensed, not sold, and Olympus and its licensors retain ownership of all copies of the Run-Time Module. Section X. (Effective Period)

1. This Agreement shall become effective as of the date when you agree to this Agreement and install the Software.
2. In the event that you breach any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, this Agreement shall be terminated. In such a case, you must immediately cease to use the Software and delete or destroy all of the Software and its copies.

Section XI. (Governing Law and Jurisdiction)

1. If any provision of this EULA is held to be void, invalid, unenforceable or illegal, the other provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
2. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Germany.
3. With respect to any controversies arising from this Agreement, you agree to exclusive jurisdiction and venue in Hamburg, Germany.
